**TO ALL UASU MEMBERS**

Good afternoon UASU Members,

As you will recall, UASU - UoN initiated a withdrawal of labour campaign across ALL Faculties at the beginning of the Semester on 3rd October 2022, purposefully seeking payments from the Module 2 program to its Service Providers. This campaign preceded various correspondences with the University Management that had gone unanswered.

The objective of UASU – UoN remains honourable, and as social partners to the University Management, we remain steadfast that UoN MUST succeed. Indeed, our doors to negotiate and sustain industrial harmony are always open. We remain alive to our objectives, especially during difficult times, which is why the UASU – UoN team honoured a last-minute meeting with the University Management today, Sunday, 23rd October 2022, to break the impasse that has been affecting the Module 2 Program.

In the meeting this afternoon, the Vice Chancellor owned to paying a lumpsum of Ksh. 55 Million to Service Providers across faculties since the beginning of the withdrawal of labour on 3rd October to date. The Union negotiated a further Ksh. 55m which shall be paid between tomorrow 24<sup>th</sup> Oct 2022 and 25th October 2022 making a total of Ksh. 110m in the month of October 2022. Faculty Representatives will have details of individual Faculty payments.

Further, the Vice Chancellor pledged to set aside a standing figure of Ksh. 50 Million Monthly to continue retiring the debt owed to Service Providers of this program starting 1st November 2022 while keeping up with current payments.

We thank all our members for their patience as UASU – UoN navigated this impasse and we promise to remain your labour champions. We also take this opportunity to call on our elected Deans, who are our Academic and Administrative heads in our respective Faculties, and who handle Module 2 intakes, to ensure payments to Service Providers as negotiated by UASU – UoN are made.

UASU – UoN, therefore, declares a moratorium on the withdrawal of labour to the Module 2 Program and urges our members to resume their respective assignments on Monday, 24th October 2022.
